

OIB ONGOING ASSESSMENT (50%)


- 10 % bases of the general average of 11th and 1th grades report card (weighted at 10).
- 40 % for the internal assessment held in 11th and 12th grades in the following subjects: Language B, Sciences, Elective # 1, P.E (each W.@5) Specific test for English and History-Geography, Oral and Written (Weighted at 15 each, THEREFORE 25% of the total grade



WHAT IS THE IB DIPLOMA?


The IB diploma is awarded by the International Baccalaureate
Organization to those students who complete the following requirements:

- Receive an average mark in the required 6 subject areas;
- Write and submit an Extended Essay
- Write an essay and organize an exhibition on a variety of TOK subjects
- Complete a minimum of 150 creativity, action and service activities (CAS)



IB DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS AT ROCHAMBEAU

- 6 mandatory courses;
- 3 courses at the **standard level**: 150 hrs/2 years or 3 hrs/week
- 3 courses at the **higher level**: 240 hrs/2 years or 4 hrs/week;
- 3 additional requirements: CAS, Extended Essay, and TOK
 - mandatory French class
- 1 mandatory PE class that does not





Additional Options

US Math

- Prepare students for calculus and help students prepare for standardized exams including the Praxis, PSAT, SAT, SAT Math 1 & 2, and ACT. Then, AP exams
- 10th grade: Statistics, Trigonometry, Vectors, Matrices
- 11th grade: Series and Sequences, Conic Sections, Number Theory, Introduction to Calculus, The Derivative



Advanced Topic US History



- Scope: pre-Columbian native-Americans and finishing with the beginning of the twenty first century.
- Focus on a deeper understanding of the various eras through organizational and historical analysis of the events, actors, and issues.
